

Kil[®] Amitraz

Insecticide against ticks and scabies for dogs.

Formula

Amitraz (as Amitraz 100 %) 12.5 g
Excipients q.s. 100.0 mL

Indications

Kil Amitraz is an external antiparasitic, active against ticks and scabies in dogs.

By using it the following parasites can be controlled:

Rhipicephallus sanguineus (common dog tick)

Sarcoptes scabiei (scabies)

Demodex canis (demodectic mange)

Notoedres cati (notoedric mange)

Dosage and Administration

KIL Amitraz is a product for external use. It can be applied through spray applications, immersion baths and topical treatments of localized lesions.

The bath solution should be prepared according to the following dosage:

* Ticks: 2 mL: 1 liter of water (250 ppm)

* Demodectic or sarcoptic mange: 4 mL: 1 liter of water (500 ppm)

The resulting emulsion should be applied to a clean dry dog. It should be applied liberally covering the affected body surface. When used as a rinse after bathing, it is important that the animal be dry before it is applied.

For treatment of scabies (sarcoptic, demodectic or notoedric): apply weekly until thirty days after symptoms have completely disappeared. Some cases of demodexia require booster treatments every 2 to 8 weeks for long periods of time, even lifelong. The duration of treatment should always be at the discretion of the acting veterinarian.

Emulsions of this product in water should be used immediately after preparation. Discard any excess.
