Dexaflox[®]

Eye drops containing a broad-spectrum antibiotic and corticosteroids. Canines, felines and horses.

Indications:

DEXAFLOX is indicated in canines, felines and horses for the treatment of inflammation, both associated and not associated to infection, affecting the anterior aspect of the eye, such as conjunctivitis, blepharitis, blepharoconjunctivitis and keratoconjunctivitis. In felines, it is indicated for the treatment of inflammation, both associated and not associated to infection, and for conjunctivitis, blepharitis, blepharoconjunctivitis and keratoconjunctivitis resulting from injuries.

Ofloxacin offers control and prevention of infections caused by different bacteria, including: Gram-positive Bacteria: Staphylococcus aureus, Staphylococcus epidermidis, Staphylococcus pneumoniae. Gram-negative Bacteria: Enterobacter cloacae, Haemophilus influenzae, Proteus mirabilis, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Serratia marcescens.

Dosage and Directions for Use:

Instill one drop of Dexaflox in each eye every 12 hours. Frequency of application must be established by the treating veterinarian, according to the severity of the case, and can be increased up to 2 or 3 times a day. Directions for Use: Dexaflox is administered only in the eye. To ensure ease of administration, one hand should be placed on the patient's forehead, while holding the dropper containing the medication 1-2 cm above the conjunctival sac. Holding the forehead and keeping the dropper at a safe distance prevents both injuries to the eye and contamination of the dropper. Drop the medication on the conjunctival sac located in the inside corner of the eye.
