# **Ocuflox**®

Eye drops containing broad-spectrum antibiotic. Active ingredients to facilitate cicatrisation. Indicated in canines, felines and horses.

### Indications:

OCUFLOX is indicated in canines, felines and horses, for the treatment of bacterial keratitis, acute and chronic bacterial conjunctivitis, bacterial ulcers, blepharitis, dacryoadenitis, dacryocystitis and other eye infections caused by sensitive strains. It is also indicated for pre and post surgical prophylaxis. Its content of natural polymers, such as Sodium Hyaluronate and Chondroitin Sulfate, facilitates healing processes at the cornea and the conjunctiva.

Ofloxacin is a broad-spectrum antibiotic agent that affects the following microorganisms: Gram-positive Bacteria Staphylococcus aureus, Staphylococcus epidermidis, Streptococcus pneumoniae. Gram-negative bacteria: Enterobacter cloacae, Haemophilus influenzae, Proteus mirabilis, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Serratia marcescens.

# **Dosage and Administration:**

Instill one drop of Ocuflox in each eye every 24 hours. Frequency of application must be established by the treating veterinarian, according to the severity of the case, and can be increased up to 2 or 3 times a day. Treatment should continue for at least two days after relief of symptoms has been achieved, or as indicated by the veterinarian.

Directions for Use: Ocuflox is administered only in the eye. To ensure ease of administration, one hand should be placed on the patient's forehead, while holding the dropper containing the medication 1-2 cm above the conjunctival sac. Holding the forehead and keeping the dropper at a safe distance prevents both injuries to the eye and contamination of the dropper. Drop the medication on the conjunctival sac located in the inside corner of the eye.
